1- EUROPEAN GREEN DEAL

(Striving to be the first climate-neutral continent)

Climate change and environmental degradation are an existential threat to Europe and the world. To overcome these challenges, the European Green Deal will transform the EU into a modern, resource-efficient and competitive economy, ensuring:

- No net emissions of greenhouse gases by 2050,
- Economic growth decoupled from resource use,
- No person and no place left behind.

The European Green Deal is also our lifeline out of the COVID-19 pandemic. **One third of the €1.8 trillion** investments from the Next Generation EU Recovery Plan, and the EU's seven-year budget will finance the European Green Deal.

The European Commission has adopted a set of proposals to make the EU's climate, energy, transport and taxation **policies fit for reducing net greenhouse gas emissions by at least 55% by 2030**, compared to 1990 levels. More information on Delivering the European Green Deal.

1.1.Highlights

Pollinators

Reversing the decline of wild pollinators in the EU and contributing to the global action.

Overview

Europe is home to an amazing variety of insects that pollinate crops and wild plants. This variety is essential for a healthy nature and our wellbeing. However, in recent decades, wild-insect pollinators such as bees, butterflies, hoverflies and moths have dramatically declined in abundance and diversity in Europe. Many species are on the verge of extinction.

Without pollinators, our food security will be at risk and many plant species will decline and eventually disappear. This threatens the survival of nature, human wellbeing and the economy.

Partner Organizations are sharing their good practices / projects related green and clean environment in their region or country.

2.1.Planned Project Activities and Events

- 1. Online and face-to-face training on environment for all project teams by experts in the field of environment,
- 2. Exchange Environmental based Good Green Practices and Projects,
- 3. Transnational Meeting and Green Awareness Activities in Dalyan,
- 4. Green Conference and Green Exhibition Green Awareness Activities in Antalya,
- 5. Building Project Partnerships on Environment at Local Level,
- 6. Building Transnational Project Partnership as New Partnership Model
- 7. Disseminating Project results /outputs in the Project Countries.

2.2.Type and Number of person benefiting from Project

5 Non-Governmental Organizations from 5 countries are collaborating in the project. Direct beneficiaries of the project: A total of 100 people, including 16 Youth-workers, 13 Experts and external Evaluators, 36 Young People, 35 Young Volunteers, The number of indirect beneficiaries (local partners and volunteers) is 140 people.

2.3.Expected Results & Outputs

1-Local and Transnational Cooperation Model on Sustainable clean and green environment and clean sea, lake, river and water sources.

2- To raise awareness for a clean and green environment in the regions and project countries and the EU.

3- To improve the knowledge and skills of the project participants iabout the clean and green environment and natural sources,

We are using online questionnaire to evaluate ourselves and our project activities and this online questionnaire is open for everybody. First online questionnaire is done at the work package 1 second one is done on the work package 4. We are assigning external evaluator to control quality of project products such as Collaboration Model, Compiling Good projects and practices for new Models,

2.5.Background and general objectives

"Let us think green" project covers 3 priorities of the Erasmus+ program 2022,

- 1- Environment and fight against climate change,
- 2- Participation in democratic life,

3- Digital Transformation.

"The issues of environment and climate are one of the main priority areas for the EU, both today and in the future. The Green European Order is the new growth strategy of a developing and growing Europe. It is necessary for schools, educational institutions and universities to protect the environment and climate by 2050 and achieve a successful recognizes its key role in engaging with young people, families and the wider community on the changes necessary for the transition.

In the summer of 2021, a part of the forest areas in Mugla and Antalya in Turkiye burned down for various reasons. Similar forest fires occur in the summer seasons in some of the Mediterranean countries, such as Greece, Italy, and Spain. Reforestation of these burned regions takes many years. On the other hand, as urbanization increases, green areas decrease every year." Let us think green " project includes awareness training and awareness activities for the development and protection of green areas, keeping blue and clean sea, lakes and river sides, drinkable water sources and clean atmosphere.

5 non-governmental organizations from Turkiye, Italy, Lithuania, Greec and Bulgaria are cooperating to implement the targets of "Let us Think Green" Project

In the project, Managers, workers, youth of Non-Governmental Organizations and local administrations, experts from Governmental Organizations, Universities, Private Companis are collabrating to develop collaboration network from local to EU LEVEL for sustainable green and clean environment, blue and clean sea and clean atmosphere.

All activities and events held in this context and are disseminated to large groups thorugh social media, local media and dissemination meetings and activities in the project countries.

Managers, youth-workers and young people of partner and associate partners of NGOs have a chance to participate in democratic life by using social media and digital technologies and cooperating with local and national policy makers.

The project content have important tools to build knowledge, skills and attitudes on green, clean sustainable environment and water sources both within the European Union and in the EU neighbourhood countries.

Planned training, awareness events, conference, exhibition in Mugla and Antalya and dissemination meetings are organized in the all project countries by using effective methods in region, country and EU. Developed collaboration model and project activities, awareness events are shared on the social media of project organization.

2.6. Needs analysis and specific objectives

The following activities and activities have been planned within the scope of the project in order to reach the priority targets of Europe above.

1- Online Trainings and Discussions between project partners and local stakeholders for the Protection and Development of Green and Clean Environment and clean atmosphere,

2- To create a sustainable cooperation infrastructure on green environment between youth non-governmental organizations and their employees and becoming one of the actors of policy makers,

3- On Green Environment Event In Muğla and Antalya to implement project activities We are collaborating with the Environmental Units of the Provincial and District Municipalities, the Environmental Directorates of the Government in the Provinces, the Forestry Operations Directorates, the 2 selected High Schools, the students and academicians in the Environmental or Close Engineering Departments of the Universities in the provinces in the activities within the scope of the project.

4- Good practices on Green and Clean Environment and clean atmosphere, awareness events /protest about green and clean environment and collaboration model in the communities in the project partner countries are transferred to the project pool and provides exchange of ideas among partners and are sharing Project countries with social media.

5- First project meeting will be held in Muğla-Dalyan (October 2023). 3 representatives(at least one is Young) from partner organizations and 10 Stakeholders from Turkiye are coming together to discuss the work-packages and are visiting local stake-holders and are organizing some green and clean environment awareness activities in Mugla.

6- In the next period, the project partners are carrying out their project studies on the Green and Clean Environment, clean atmosphere in their own countries within the framework of the Project work packages.

7- Second meeting is being organized in Antalya(May 2024) It is a 5-days program (Green Conference and Green exhibition and visiting some Local partners and participating in 2 green environment awareness activities with local media representatives. in the "Green" exhibition, project products (Photography and Video of Good practices / projects, Green Brochure, Sustainable Cooperation Model Document) are exhibited at the exhibition salon of the Conference hotel.

This event is held in cooperation with the Municipality. 4 representatives (at least 2 young people) from each project country will participate in the project.

Provincial representatives of the Central government, Municipality, Non-Governmental Organizations, Policy makers and academicians and students from universities are invited to Green conference and Green exhibitions from Antalya city.

8-Project partners are establishing a Project management and coordination core group(Project coordinator, Youth worker, Youth and Volunteers) and are also establishing local partnerships in their region to implement project activities at the country level.

9-Project partners are arranging one day dissemination meetings in their cities and are disseminating project products/outputs. New Collaboration model for sustainable green and clean environment, clean atmosphere, clean water, sea, lake and river and are sharing

project experiences with local stake-holders of their countries.1 representatives from TEK-SAV participate in dissemination meetings of the Project countries.

10-Project partners continue partnership after the Project and Project webpage is kept at least 2 years after the project.

2.7. European Added Value

5 youth organizations from 5 different countries are cooperating in the project.

Selected countries are different regions of Europe and this is the reflection of Europe on the project from different angles. The European Union's Green Deal Action is the basement of the project and we are walking to these identified targets with project partners and are organizing awareness in our regions and our countries by the help of social media and local media.

The European Union's Green Deal Action comprises:

To reduce the Greenhouse gases to the rates determined by the European Union by 2050, The use of edible materials in nature instead of the use of plastic,

Using clean water resources,

Establishment of treatment plants to reuse household waste,

Encouraging afforestation works in forests, parks, roadsides,

Establishing close contact with target groups in order to reduce gas emissions, to encourage the use of renewable materials in nature instead of plastic materials, to protect and develop water resources, to raise awareness of students and local people on the protection and development of a green environment.

Project partners will exchange their good practices/projects related to the green and clean environment in project countries to have some ideas for a green and clean environment with other project partners. These models will be the essence of our project targets in addition to EU targets.

at least 6 different good practices /projects/ activities and recommendations will be included in the" Let us think green " project pool to aspire to all project participants.

In addition, the objectives of the European Union in its reports on the Green, clean and sustainable Environment will also be core of the project.

The results of the online surveys for a green and clean EU in the project countries will be an important indicator for our project works and activities. We are developing a new partnership and collaboration model as Local and Transnational Level for developing Green and Clean Environment in the EU.

For example, the "Green Deal Action Plan" report published by the Ministry of Commerce of Turkey in November 2021 shows the road map of Turkiye. Similar target reports are reflected in the project, if there is similar report in the project countries, these reports are used in our project.

The project results and awareness activities are published on the project website and social media pages in English. Links to project activities and project reports are provided on social media. The project final report is shared with the relevant ministries of the countries, We are cooperating with Universities or Research centres, VET Schools, Municipalities in our Local area to disseminate project results.

In this way, the project is disseminated through various methods both project countries and European level.

Pics, videos of meetings, Green conference, Green exhibitions, Training with project groups, visits to local partners, awareness events, dissemination activities are uploaded to project

web pages and are uploaded to project social media pages to disseminate all project activities in the project countries and EU. Partner organizations are giving the link from their web pages and social media pages. Partner NGOs are sharing good practices & projects together on social media in Turkiye and other project countries.

At least, we are announcing the green and clean environment targets of Europe to large groups /communities through this project.

2.8. Planning and Methodology

In the "Let us think Green "project; Planning, Methodology, Cost effectiveness studies are as follows.

TEK-SAV is the lead Non-Governmental organization of the project, is assigning a project coordinator, 2 mentors and 1 Youth-worker to manage and coordinate the project activities. Project partners are appointing 1 project coordinator and at least 1 youth worker to manage and coordinate the project. These are the core group of the project in the implantation and coordination of the project.

Funds are allocated from the budget for the establishment of a local cooperation network, the dissemination of the project, and the assignment of Youth and Volunteers to each project partner for the participation of young people in the project.

4 (Four) Work-Packages have been defined with some period and some project applications.

In the work packages, the activities and events to be carried out in the project are defined in general.

The details of the duties and responsibilities that are generally defined in the work packages will be determined in detail by discussing with the project partners during the project implementation phase.

There is close cooperation between the project coordinators for the quality assurance of the project. On-line questionnaires, on the other hand, will be an indicator of the quality of the project activities done.

The budget amounts defined for the realization of the activities are both compatible with the standard values (Travel, subsistence, monthly cost of person) determined by the European Union.

Sufficient resources have been allocated to carry out the activities falling under the responsibility of each project partner. Details can be seen in the Excel budget table.

In the project, non-governmental organizations from 5 European countries are cooperating on a green, clean and sustainable environment and clean atmosphere.

Each partner organization is directly contributing to the project with 1 youth worker and at least 4 young people and 5 Volunteers who have competence and skills in the green and clean environment.

Youth workers, Mentors, Young People and Volunteers are creating positive synergy in the project. Selections of Youth-workers, young people and Volunteers are made according to clear and objective criteria. TEK-SAV is following to see proof of each project events or activities. All project partners are taking precautions to ensure gender balance.

1- Project groups are informed by online trainings by experts on the green and clean environment,

2- TEK-SAV experts are informing the project team about the aims and targets of the project and the project duties, responsibilities and activities in the first 5 months of the project,

3- Good environmental practices or projects of each country are transferred to the project pool to develop new project model of "Let us think green" project

4- There are discussions on the green, clean and sustainable environment and clean atmosphere with online meetings among the project partners,

5- The managers and experts of the governmental or Non-Governmental organizations related to the environment and the at least 2 academicians working in the Environment in the region are informed about the "Let us think green" project and communication and collaboration are kept during the project.

6- Opinions of various groups on our green and clean environmental activities and studies are evaluated with online Google surveys.

7- Awareness are raised through various environmental activities (tree planting, cleaning of picnic areas, beaches and seasides, rivers, visits to treatment plants, energy production units, etc.). Cooperation is implemented with local municipalities and relevant units of the governmental organizations and Non-Governmental organizations and University at the city level.

8- The project is completed with the opening of the Green exhibition in which exhibited all the project visible products and documents and in the conference all the project studies and cooperation model among the organization to keep clean, green and sustainable in Antalya-Turkiye.

Project results are disseminated in both project countries and European Union countries in cooperation with our social media pages and local media

2.9. Management, quality, monitoring and evaluation strategy

The project coordinator shared the project's work packages, time planning, objectives and targets of the "Let us think Green" project with the project coordinators of the project partner organizations before the project mandate letter was signed.

So all partners have necessary information and tasks and also know what, when and how to do it.

After the project is approved, the planned activities are carried out according to the workpackage and time planning of the project.

The quality of all project activities, methods and reports are evaluated through regular online meetings with the project coordinators.

During the project, project studies are evaluated with half-day on-line meetings at least once every 2 months. Project coordinators are attending the meeting. If necessary, the number of online meetings are increased.

All the work done is uploaded to TRELLO (<u>https://trello.com/en</u>)and other people are observing the work done.

During the implementation phase of the project, all participants are discussing in detail in both online and face-to-face meetings.

TEK-SAV is assigning 1 youth-worker and 2 Mentors and 5 young volunteers (see 2.1.3) during the project activities in Turkiye and is taking measures when necessary and project partners and stakeholders are developing green and clean environmental based local collaboration models with some environmental awareness and activities in Mugla.

Similar assignments were made in Antalya for WP-3 applications. Managers and representatives of environmental units and a group of University students are also participating in project activities.

In addition, the cooperation models developed on the for Project and the reports for country, region and Europe are evaluated in terms of quality through face-to-face or online meetings with both internal and external stakeholders and experts.

Within the scope of Work Package 2 in Muğla, 1 expert for online training and 2 experts from the Project field for Quality assurance of Project products were assigned. Similar assignments were made for WP3 for Antalya events.

Another quality control process is carrying out online questionnaires for target groups. Evaluation surveys will be conducted in Muğla, Antalya events and dissemination meetings in project partner countries, and the evaluations and suggestions of the participants are received in this way. At the end of the project, all evaluations are published on the project website.

Air quality (air pollution, ozone pollution, ties to human health with asthma, diesel emissions, etc.)

Awareness-raising activities (aim to make learners more aware of language and so improve their understanding, but do not involve learners in using the language themselves.) Sea and Beach cleaning (process of removing solid litter, dense chemicals, and organic debris deposited on a beach and sea or coastline by the tide, local visitors, or tourists) Biodiversity (conservation of biological diversity in the natüre)

Biointensive agriculture (organic agricultural system that focuses on achieving maximum yields from a minimum area of land, while simultaneously increasing biodiversity and sustaining the fertility of the soil)

Carbon emissions (Pollution released into the atmosphere from carbon dioxide and carbon monoxide; often produced by motor vehicles)

Carbon footprint (The amount of carbon dioxide produced by your lifestyle)

Circular economy (A system dedicated to eliminating waste by reusing, sharing, repairing, and recycling resources)

Climate change (encompasses "global warming", greenhouse effect, loss of glaciers, climate refugees, climate justice, equity, etc)

Climate positive (Exceeding achieving carbon neutrality by removing additional carbon dioxide from the atmosphere; also referred to as carbon negative)

Eco-Environment (The word "eco" is an abbreviation for the word, "ecology" which is the science of the relationships between organisms and their environments)

Ecosystem (a geographic area where plants, animals, and other organisms, as well as weather and landscape, work together to form a bubble of life. Ecosystems contain biotic or living, parts, as well as abiotic factors, or nonliving parts)

Ecotourism (tourism involving responsible travel to natural areas, conserving the environment, and improving the well-being of the local people)

Energy (use, conservation, extraction of resources to create energy, efficient use, renewable energy, etc.)

Environmental awareness (means being aware of the natural environment and making choices that benefit the earth, rather than hurt it)

The European Green Deal (aims to boost the efficient use of resources by moving to a clean, circular economy and stop climate change, revert biodiversity loss and cut pollution) Food safety (including food justice, impacts of additives, etc.)

Global environmental issues (the various environmental problems that are happening all around the world. These problems include pollution, global warming, ozone depletion, acid rain, depletion of natural resources, overpopulation etc.)

Global warming (gradual increase in the earth's temperature generally due to the greenhouse effect caused by increased levels of carbon dioxide, other pollutants) Green: (is used to describe behavior, product, policies, people, etc. that minimize environmental damage and protecting green areas)

Green economy (aims at reducing environmental risks and ecological scarcities, and that aims for sustainable development without degrading the environment)

Green Energy (Renewable energy comes from sources that are constantly and naturally renewed (hence the name), such as wind power and solar energy)

"Green Environment" (relates to the concerns for environmental conservation and improved health of the environment)

Greenhouse effect (When excessive heat is trapped and built up in the troposphere by a blanket of gases.)

Green Sustainability (means using environmentally friendly products and services. Sustainability means using products or services in a way that does not damage the future generations' resources)

Habitat (the place or environment where a plant or animal naturally or normally lives and grows)

Natural resources (plant and animal stocks, mineral resources (mining), etc.) Pollution (air, water, land, toxins, light, point source and non-point source, use of coal/gas/etc., reclaimed land issues)

Permaculture (an approach to land management and settlement design that adopts arrangements observed in flourishing natural ecosystems)

Reduce, reuse, repair and recycle (reprocess reusable goods and materials such as plastics, glassess, paper, organic waste.)

Renewable Energy (Energy which is collected from renewable resources like the sun, wind, waves and geothermal heat)

Soil conservation (includes soil erosion, contamination and salination of land, especially fertile land)

Sustainability (finding ways to live more sustainably on the planet, lessening human footprint, increasing human fulfillment with less impact)

Toxic chemicals (persistent organic pollutants, prior informed consent, pesticides, endocrine disruptors, etc.)

Waste (landfills, recycling, incineration, various types of waste produced from human endeavors, etc.)

Waste management or waste disposal (includes the processes and actions required to manage <u>waste</u> from its inception to its final disposal)

Water pollution (fresh water and ocean pollution, river and lake pollution, riparian issues)

INTERNET RESEARCH

1.1.Environment Management, Coordination, Regulation, Inspection and Monitoring in Türkiye.

The Ministry of Environment, Urbanization and Climate Change is the highest authority in Turkey on environmental regulations, inspections and monitoring. There are Provincial Directorates of the Ministry of Environment, Urbanization and Climate Change in every province of Turkiye.

The General Directorate of Environmental Management, affiliated to the Ministry, is the unit related to the protection of the environment [1].

The Turkish government has signed important international Agreements on the environment and the seas. The Turkish government signed the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCOCC) in 2003 and the Kyoto agreement in 2009. Turkey became a party to the Vienna Convention and the Montreal Protocol on the Protection of the Ozone Layer in 1991. The Turkish government signed the Bucharest agreement in 1996 for the protection of the Black Sea and its coasts, and signed the Barcelona agreement in 2002 for the protection of the Mediterranean Sea and its coasts.

The Instrument for Pre-Accession Financial Assistance Environmental Operations Program (IPA-I, IPA-II, IPA-III) with the European Union has realized environmental projects[2].

There are some special environmental protection areas in Turkiye . Their number is 19. One of them is Köyceğiz-Dalyan Special Environmental Protection Area and it is one of the best practices to be transferred to Let us think Green project[3]. The European Union called for a project of 5 million Euros in February 2023 to increase the capacities of civil society organizations in Turkey to support the achievement of the ambitious goals of the European Green Deal[4].

1.2. Municipalities and Environment

Municipalities have responsibilities and authorities on the protection of green environment and clean water resources. The Environmental Protection and Control Department in Municipalities was established to manage and monitor environmental activities[5]. Some municipalities provide services to citizens with education and innovation centers related to the environment[6].

1.3.Environmental Engineering Departments at Universities

There are Environmental Engineering departments in 29 universities in Turkey [7]. Majority of the graduates work in the Ministry of Environment, Urbanization and Climate Change, Universities and Governmental Organizations and Municipalities.

Köyceğiz-Dalyan Special Environmental Protection Area

General Characteristics: The Iztuzu beach area in the region is one of the most important breeding grounds for sea turtles (Caretta caretta and Chelonia mydas) and Nile tortoises (Trionyx triunguis) in the Mediterranean. In addition, the region is the breeding and living area of the otter species (Lutra lutra). 126 bird species, 282 marine fauna and flora species have been identified in the region.

Köyceğiz-Dalyan Special Environmental Protection Area; Muğla province, Köyceğiz district and 4 towns connected to it, consists of 13 villages. Köyceğiz is a town 75 km away from Muğla province. The region consists of different landforms located around the Köyceğiz depression lake. The northeast and southeast of the lake are flat, while the other parts are surrounded by hilly areas. The section between Köyceğiz Lake and the sea is covered with 4 small lakes and numerous canals. The coastline consists of a 4.5 km long shore arrow. It is one of the most important breeding grounds for sea turtles (Caretta Caretta) in the Mediterranean.

There is a fault line in the northwest - southeast direction south of Öycegiz Lake. Depending on this fault, there are various thermal springs known as Sultaniye, Çavuş (Rıza Çavuş) and Gel Girme (Kokar Girme). The parts of Muğla province other than Fethiye and Kınık are the region called Caria (Caria) in ancient times. B.C. Founded in the 8th century, Caria first came under the rule of Helen, then Lydia, Persia, Egypt, Syria, Pergamum, and finally Byzantium. It joined the borders of the Menteşe Principality in 1425 and the Ottoman Empire in 1535.




Fig.5. Dalyan Map and Top View of Dalyan

The most common vegetation in the Köyceğiz Special Environmental Protection Area consists of red pine and log forests, shrubs and shrub plants belonging to maquis and frigana, as well as herbaceous plants growing in the wet and barren swamps around Köyceğiz Lake. Pine pine (Pinus Pinea) is also seen on the coast. dominates.

Caretta carettas, which use the Iztuzu beach as a breeding ground, are also under protection as they are under the threat of extinction. Lake surroundings, canals and forests have a rich potential as breeding and sheltering places for various animals.




Fig.7. Dalyan river and historical places from Roman Time

Sakarmeke, stork, Izmir kingfisher, swallow, reed nightingale, laughing tern, snake eagle, bee-eater, seagull, paddyfish, little white heron and various other bird species use the region as wintering and hatching areas.

A planning approach, which is based on the preservation of the natural qualities of Öycegiz Lake and Dalyan Strait and parallel to the general principles, has been followed. Dalyan and Köyceğiz, which are completely sensitive, are very valuable both in natural, historical and ecological terms. At the same time, Dalyan is a settlement where tourism investments are concentrated. Köyceğiz Lake, rivers, Dalyan Canal, Dalyan mouth and the sea are particularly vulnerable to pollution and are areas that need to be protected.

It was aimed to grow the settlements of Köyceğiz and Dalyan in their own development areas, with intensive construction in these areas, especially tourism, traditional production, hostel business, farm tourism, recreational use of Köyceğiz lake, development of spa tourism, protection of citrus orchards, and plan decisions were developed to support these topics. An exemplary project has been developed by developing an arrangement that enables the use of sea turtles in the Dalyan mouth / lztuzu area and the protection of their breeding areas, but the use of this area, where people also use sea and sand, by day people by night turtles.

- 2- Caretta Caretta turtles laying their eggs on the Iztuzu beach in the region,
- 3- The region has rare animal (Mainly birds) and plant species







GOOD PRACTICE II Konyaaltı Beach and Lara Beach in Antalya

KONYAALTI BEACH

Antalya is one of the most important tourist centers of both Turkey, Europe and the world. The closest beaches to Antalya's city center are Konyaaltı and Lara Beaches. Thousands of people swim in these 2 beaches for about 7 months of the year and relax in their green areas and parks[9].

The important feature of both beaches is the combination of blue and green. When people come out of the sea, they have the opportunity to rest on the green ground under their green trees when they pass the beach. In both beaches, the beach is kept clean and the green area is protected as green and clean. With these features, both Konyaaltı beach and Lara beaches are included as good practice in the Let us think Green Project.

As one of Turkey's most famous beaches, Konyaaltı Beach serves visitors with its approximately 7 km coastline. Besides the public beach, Konyaaltı Beach, which has more than 30 beaches run by different businesses, is mostly covered with small pebbles, although there is fine sand in some parts. Adorning the blue shore of the Mediterranean with its beauty, the beach offers you all the opportunities to enjoy the sea all day long. You can easily reach Konyaaltı Beach, one of the symbols of Antalya, from all points of the city centre[10,11].




Fig.12.Konyaaltı Beach and Green Recreation Area

LARA BEACH

Lara, which takes its name from the Hittite language, means sand in this language. The sand structure of the region stands out with its fine grain. Located 12 km from Antalya city centre, Lara Beach hosts a 2 km sandy road. The beach, which fascinates visitors with its nature surrounded by pine forests, is also a public beach. Lara Beach is one of the most important beaches of Antalya and the world, where the sea and green meet the beach[12].
